**Qualification for the post of Assistant Professor of Curator in
University of Agricultural Sciences, Bangalore.**

Qualifications:

- i. Good academic record with at least 55% (Traditional) or 60% (Trimester) or 70% (Semester) marks or its equivalent at the Master's Degree level in M.Sc.(Agri.) in Agricultural Entomology/M.Sc.(Agri.) in Apiculture subject from a recognized University.
- ii. NET is Compulsory. The candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by UGC, CSIR, ICAR or similar test accredited by the UGC like SLET/SET.
- iii. Essentiality of NET can be waived-off for the candidates holding Ph.D. degree provided it has been done with course work as prescribed by the UGC Regulations 2009, and the candidate has at least two full length publications having a NAAS rating not less than four (4)/ minimum of four full length papers in NAAS rated State Agricultural Universities (SAUs) Journals on the last date of submission of application. Those candidates with Ph.D. degree without course work will not qualify for NET exemption.
- iv. NET shall not be required for such Masters Programmes in disciplines for which NET is not conducted by ICAR/UGC/CSIR or SLET/SET of State Government.
- v. Pay Scale Rs.15600-39100+6000 AGP(UGC/ICAR 2006 Pay Package-subject to revision from time to time)

Note:

1. Out of the total marks secured at Master's Degree level, relaxation of 5% may provided for SC/ST Category.
2. Candidates with knowledge of Kannada are preferred for Teaching/Research/ Extension posts at the entry level in the University (Mandatory for KVK posts).

Desirable:

Proven track record in taxonomic research based on publications, experience in curating taxonomic collections and type specimens, work experience in museums, skilled in scientific illustrations including macro and micro-photography, digitization of museum data, knowledge of material transfer etc. Doctorate in insect taxonomy is highly desirable.

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
